## **Expectations:**

- You are expected to be in tune and ready to play by 12:00PM on rehearsal days.
- **You are expected to have all of the equipment (mutes, music doubles, pencils, cords etc.) needed for each rehearsal and performance.**
- You are expected to listen to the prepared listenings **before** the first class day of each week. The listening links will be posted on the GOOGLE DRIVE.
- You are expected to have practiced, and to be prepared to play the charts that are on the weekly rehearsal schedule.
- You are expected to attend all sectionals (**notify your section leader. They will then notify me, Joshua Ferrell.**)
- Course information will be given out via email. You will need to provide me with your email, so that you can join the Five O'Clock Lab Band email chain

## **Attendance:**

- Members are expected to attend all rehearsals.
- Substitutes may be sent to rehearsals **if you notify me in advance.** Failure to do so may result in a consequent change in the students letter grade.
- It is **your responsibility** to make sure your sub has **your music folder** and is qualified to play your chair.
- You are expected to play ALL performances and dress rehearsals that occur this semester. Rare exceptions are made on a case-by-case basis.

## **Responsibilities:**

- You are responsible for your music and music folder.
- Fines will be enforced per page of music lost and if your music folder is lost.
- You are expected to perform at all scheduled performances. In the rare case that you cannot, an exception may be made after consultation.
- You must dress appropriately for each performance, as specified before each Event.
- You are responsible to be fully attentive during rehearsals. **PHONES** can be distracting not only for the director, but also for the rest of the band. This will cause the rehearsal to flow inefficiently. You will have a designated time to check your phones.

**Grading Criteria:** You will be graded on the quality and consistency of your musical preparation in rehearsals and public performance. **Your professional attitude, as it affects the ensemble, will also be a consideration.**
