**Course Description.** This course offers a practical introduction to Baroque counterpoint. Students will write music from simple and elaborate partimenti, compose dance movements using common basic progressions, and complete small fugues. The course uses eighteenth-century materials and pedagogical techniques, setting students in the mindset of an eighteenth-century musician.

**Grading.** Assignments will be graded according to this rubric: fluent (100%), competent (85%), deficient (70%), and incomplete (0%). The final grade will be calculated to this rubric: A = 100-90%, B = 89-80%, C = 79-70%, D = 69-60%, F = 59-0%

**Assignments.** The next page provides a list of assignments and their due dates. Assignments are due at the start of class.
