Grading

The painting will take place in class. It will allow me to coach you through difficult processes and ensure you are staying on track. Each of you come to this class with a variety of experiences and skill levels. You will NOT be compared to your neighbor- you will be ask to grow from where you started- not leap to somewhere you have never been. Time management and following of instructions will be key. In Class: 800 points

Each painting project will be worth between 50-100 points. These projects can ONLY happen during class time. Time management and focus will be paramount... NOTE that I did not say painting ability or talent.... Ask questions, pay attention to detail and instructions.

Weekly Homework: 100 points

You will be asked to upload 4 sketches each week on Thursday based on what we are painting and what you see.... See the assignment sheet for more information.

Final: 100 points

The final will be a website of all your work during the semester. Please see the assignment sheet for more information.

Grading

- A: 90-100% (Outstanding, excellent work. The student performs well above the minimum criteria.)
- B: 80-89% (Good, impressive work. The student performs above the minimum criteria.)
- C: 70-79% (Solid, college-level work. The student meets the criteria of the assignment.)
- D: 60-69% (Below average work. The student fails to meet the minimum criteria.)
- F: 59 and below (Sub-par work. The student fails to complete the assignment.)
