

## EVENT RULES AND DETAILS

Major League Gaming tickets are non-transferable and non-refundable, and MLG reserves the right to deny admission to anyone who violates the terms of the MLG Ticket Agreement.

Due to fire regulations, access to the Major League Gaming events will be limited dependent on the venue. Seating will be on a first-come first-served basis.

Please note that while attending Major League Gaming events, you will be entering into areas where you may be filmed, photographed, or recorded by Major League Gaming and other attendees. The Major League Gaming Ticket Agreement requires that you release Major League Gaming and its affiliates from any and all claims that may arise related to the use of your character, likeness, and/or voice in order to attend Major League Gaming events.

## ATTENDEE AGE RESTRICTION

Spectators who are 13 to 15 years old must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian and present a signed parental consent form. Spectators who are 16 and 17 years old must present a signed parental consent form. Any spectator under the age of 13 is not permitted in the venue.

## MAJOR LEAGUE GAMING CODE OF CONDUCT

If you witness or experience any activity that puts someone's safety or enjoyment of the show at risk, inform a security guard or Major League Gaming employee and let them know. We have

escalation procedures in place to handle these kinds of situations, and we can take the appropriate action from there.

In order to ensure the event provides a safe, enjoyable, and welcoming environment for everyone, Major League Gaming reserves the right to remove from any MLG event where any person whose conduct is deemed to be disorderly or unbecoming, or who uses vulgar or abusive language.

#### ITEM RESTRICTIONS AND PROHIBITIONS

Bags up to 11" x 16" x 4" in size may be brought into the convention. Major League Gaming reserves the right to search any bags being brought into Major League Gaming events and to refuse entry if they are found to contain prohibited items below:

#### PROHIBITED ITEMS

Prohibited items include (but are not limited to):

Electronics: desktop computers, laptops, storage devices, professional video or audio recording equipment (unless requested via [pr@mlg.com](mailto:pr@mlg.com)), drones

Food: Alcohol, prepared food, glass bottles, cans

Weapons: firearms (Unless permitted by the state), fireworks, flammable liquids or aerosol products, knives, daggers, swords, clubs, maces, other crushing or edged weapons, projectiles, air guns, long bows, crossbows

Miscellaneous: large containers, large bags (exceeding 11" x 16" x 4"), strollers, skateboards, hoverboards, scooters (except for people with disabilities), pets (except service animals)

**\*\*Any attendee found to have violated the prohibited items list may be removed from Major League Gaming events.\*\***

Tablets (such as iPads) and video cameras are permitted for use in the Major League Gaming exhibit halls. However, you may not record gameplay from any of the screens.

Personal equipment may not be connected to any computer for any reason at any time.
