Scriptural Affirmations of the Preciousness of People to God

1. Humans were created in way that is distinct from the rest of creation - Genesis 1:3-27
2. Humans were brought to life by God's own breath- Genesis 2:7
3. Every human life was planned by God - Psalm 139:13-16
4. Humans are made a little lower than God himself - Psalm 8:3-6
5. Jesus affirms humans have more worth than the rest of creation - Matthew 6:26
6. God loves every human on the face of the earth – John 3:16
7. God proved His love to every Human - Romans 5:8
8. If God loves us, then we must love everyone – 1 John 4:10-11

YOUR STORY

1. In our everyday lives, it is common to struggle to know we are special, to not feel good about ourselves. Have you had such a struggle? Would you share your story?

DIGGING DEEPER INTO THE LESSON

2. Many people often look to self-help techniques to improve their self-esteem. However, the bible teaches us about how precious we are to God. I mean YOU. Let us dig deep into ways we know we are precious to God from the following scriptures:
Genesis 1:3-27; Genesis 2:7; Psalm 139:13-16; Psalm 8:3-6
Matthew 6:26; John 3:16; Romans 5:8; 1 John 4:10
3. The verses we just read tells us we are important and precious to God. But sometimes, getting that knowledge to move from our heads to our hearts and to live knowing we are of great value to God can be difficult. How can we constantly remind ourselves or live knowing we are precious to God?
