Why Are Humans Beings So Precious to God?

To fully understand why humans are precious to God, we must understand **God's vision Plan** concerning why He created the Earth and human beings.

- o God creates two domains: heaven and earth Genesis 1:1
- God created the heavens and the earth, and he wanted it to be inhabited – Isaiah 45:18
- o Heaven belongs to God and Earth belongs to humans Psalm 115:16
- o Heaven is His throne; Earth is His footstool (Colony) Acts 7:49
- Inhabitants of a territory to a kingdom are the king's property –
 Psalm 24:1
- Human beings are strangers on earth, but our citizenship is in heaven –Philippians 3:20; John 17:11, John 17:16
- Human beings are meant to rule, dominate, and reign on earth like
 kings and queens Genesis 1:26-28; Psalm 8:3-6

Picture - So, God, a king sends people from His kingdom to live in another territory called Earth which belongs to Him and the people He sent are there to rule, have dominion, reign, gain control, govern, have charge, have authority in that territory on His behalf.

What does the picture illustrate? Colonization.

Colonization – involves citizens of one country inhabiting a foreign territory to influence that territory with the King's will, culture, and values of the native country.

When a Kingdom Expands it is called Colonization.

God, who is a king, wants to expand His invisible Kingdom to the visible world so he created a territory (called earth) and citizens (called human beings) to accomplish that.

God's goal is to expand His heavenly Rule to planet Earth through human beings.

Why Are Human Beings So Precious to God?

Because human beings are the key to fulfilling God's Vision Plan of Colonizing the Earth with Heaven.

Is colonization of the earth scriptural or some human idea that is inserted into the bible?

- 1. God's Colonization intent began from the creation of heaven, earth, and human beings.
- 2. When Jesus arrived on earth, his first public statement was about the arrival of the kingdom of God Matthew 4:17, 23

From then on Jesus began to preach, "Repent, because the kingdom of heaven has come near." (Matthew 4:17, CSB)

Now Jesus began to go all over Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness among the people. (Matthew 4:23, CSB)

3. Jesus taught us to pray for colonization to occur – Matthew 6:10

Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (Matthew 6:10, CSB)

How is this Kingdom going to come (manifest itself)? – Matthew 12:28 If I drive out demons by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you. (Matthew 12:28)

4. Jesus said that the Colonization of the Earth was his purpose for coming to earth – Luke 4:43; Matthew 12:28

But he said to them, "It is necessary for me to proclaim the good news about the kingdom of God to the other towns also because I was sent for this purpose." (Luke 4:43)

5. Paul affirms colonization of earth was God's original idea in creation - Ephesians 3:9-11

And God gave me the work of telling all people about the <u>plan for his</u> <u>secret</u>, which has been hidden in him since the beginning of time. He is the One who created everything. (Ephesians 3:9, NCV)

<u>His purpose</u> was that through the church all the rulers and powers in the heavenly world will now know God's wisdom, which has so many forms. (Ephesians 3:10, NCV)

This agrees with the purpose God had since the beginning of time, and he carried out his plan through Christ Jesus our Lord. (Ephesians 3:11, NCV)

God's purpose in colonizing the Earth was to show the spiritual powers of darkness how beings created in His image could be planted on earth and they will bring in the government and culture of heaven so that in the end the earth looks like heaven.
