**Erosion** - Is the gradual destruction of something.

# **Erosion in Churches Today**

There is erosion of truth, family values, biblical foundations, true biblical preaching, Christo centric marriage, etc. across the nations of world and this is pivotal to us serving God.

Therefore, we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard, lest at <u>any time we should let them slip</u>. Hebrews 2:1 (KJV)

Erosion in a church is erosion in the life of its members.

Erosion is slow and silent.

# **The Ephesian Church Erosion**

Erosion happened to the church at Ephesus. This church was founded on solid biblical teaching, but over time erosion of what mattered occurred. And the Lord said to them they needed to be revived.

Let us trace the erosion....

Acts 18:18–21 (The Ephesians Church was Established by Paul) Acts 19:1, 7-10 (Paul established the church at Ephesus using the word of God)

Acts 19:13-20 (Overtime the Church experienced spiritual warfare – Where truth is taught falsehood will attack the truth.) Acts 19:23-41 (People will stir up trouble for the church because of their personal agenda)

Acts 20:17–32 (Leadership must warn the church about spiritual erosion.)

Even though they were warned by the apostle Paul, they failed to be on guard and to remain alert. Tragically, within a matter of years, the erosion took such a toll on their spiritual lives, the Lord finally announced for all to hear, "You have left your first love" (Revelation 2:4). Let us examine this erosion

Revelation 2:1-4

Spiritual Erosion occurred in the Ephesian Church because left their first love.

For Us today, we must watch out for Spiritual Erosion Matthew 24:12

And because iniquity shall abound, the <u>love of many shall wax cold</u>.

Matthew 24:12 (KJV)
