Please discuss the following questions with your parent/guardian using <u>The Second Article Section of the Catechism</u>, pages 119-146, as your guide.

If you were absent, please discuss the Catechism information below with your parent/guardian and answer the following questions on a separate piece of paper. Please put #4 and your name and number at the top and turn it in to Mrs. DuBois. If you were present in class, you do not need to turn your answers in, just this paper, SIGNED BY YOUR PARENT/GUARDIAN. Please turn this assignment in next Wednesday. Thank you.

- 1. Discuss with your parent: Recall some of the Bible Accounts of Jesus that you know about Jesus. In each one, share what you learned about Jesus in the Bible Account. (For example, in the account of Jesus Birth, I learned that there were many things that happened that were unique to His birth. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit; a star was over the place he was born etc.)
- 2. If someone asked you who Jesus is and what he has done for you, what would you say?
- 3. Who does the Bible say Jesus is? (Look up John 14:1-14, Luke 4:41, Matthew 16:16, Exodus 3:13-15). (
- 4. Hint-IAM-Triune God).) Notice the IAM connection with God/Jesus. What is that about?
- 5. **How** do you go about having a relationship with Jesus? What is a relationship with Jesus like?
- 6. What does **G.R.A.C.E.** stand for? (You should have written it in your catechism, if not ask Pastor or Mrs. DuBois.)
- 7. What is the connection between Jesus and **GRACE**?
- 8. When was the last time you sacrificed something (like time or an opportunity) for someone else and why did you do it?
- 9. How do you know that Jesus is God?
- 10. Why did Jesus have to be True God and True Man? Using the Catechism, (red questions 118-124), explain it in your own words. Why is this important? Why do you think some people doubt that Jesus is God?
- 11. What are some things that Jesus did while he was here on earth? How many things do you know enough about that you could you feel comfortable sharing with someone? How can you find out more?
- 12. CHALLENGE: TO FIND OUT MORE ABOUT JESUS, READ THE BOOK OF LUKE. LUKE HAS 24 CHAPTERS. IF YOU READ ONE CHAPTER A DAY, YOU COULD READ THE BOOK OF LUKE IN LESS THAN ONE MONTH. PLEASE LET US KNOW IF YOU TAKE ON THE CHALLENGE AND READ THE BOOK OF LUKE. MAYBE YOU COULD YOU DO IT AS A FAMILY, OR WITH A PARENT?
- 13. Is it harder to "believe in the Triune God" or "follow Christ's teachings"? Why?
- 14. How did the resurrection change the lives of the disciples? Read Luke 24:36-53; Question 181-D.
- 15. Are you comfortable using the name of Jesus in everyday conversation? Why or why not?
- 16. Who do you know that needs to hear about Jesus? Why? How might you disciple him/her?
