SCRIPTURE LESSON

Hebrews 10: 11-25

- ¹¹ And every priest stands day after day at his service, offering again and again the same sacrifices that can never take away sins.
¹² But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, "he sat down at the right hand of God,"¹³ and since then has been waiting "until his enemies would be made a footstool for his feet."¹⁴ For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are sanctified.¹⁵ And the Holy Spirit also testifies to us, for after saying,
¹⁶ "This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, says the Lord:
I will put my laws in their hearts,
and I will write them on their minds,"
¹⁷ he also adds,
"I will remember their sins and their lawless deeds no more."
¹⁸ Where there is forgiveness of these, there is no longer any offering for sin.
¹⁹ Therefore, my friends, since we have confidence to enter the sanctuary by the blood of Jesus,²⁰ by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain (that is, through his flesh),²¹ and since we have a great priest over the house of God,²² let us approach with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.²³ Let us hold fast to the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who has promised is faithful.
²⁴ And let us consider how to provoke one another to love and good deeds,²⁵ not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day approaching.
