SERMON NOTES

Series: Revelation Unveiled

Sermon Title: The Seven Seals – The Awakening of Judgement! – Rev 6:1-6

- I. The First Seal: A White Horse and Rider – 6:1-2
 - Who is the Rider? The Anti-Christ
 - His purpose: To Conquer. . . but not forever.
 - II. The Second Seal: The Red Horse and Rider – 6:3-4
 - Second Horseman: War and Bloodshed
 - His purpose: Destroy peace and bring about war
 - III. The Third Seal: The Black Horse and Rider – 6:5-6
 - His horse speaks to his character: darkness.
 - His destiny: To control food distribution while protecting the rich
 - IV. The Fourth Seal: The Pale Horse and Rider – 6:7-8
 - His name is DEATH and he's followed by Hell
 - His destiny: To kill ¼ of the earth's population by war and famine
 - V. The Fifth Seal: The Slain Martyrs – 6:9-11
 - Slain for faithfulness to God's Word and Testimony, they reside under the altar.
 - Crying out for justice, they are given white robes and assured justice is coming.
 - VI. The Sixth Seal: the Great Day of God's Wrath begins as the Universe is shattered – 6:12-17
 - Nature gives way to God's wrath
 - An earthquake
 - The sun and moon blackened as stars or meteorites shower the earth
 - The Heavens "rolled up" and land masses will be moved
 - People give way to God's wrath as well
 - Great fear sweeps over unbelievers as they cry out for death
 - Panic among humanity as God's wrath becomes evident
- A Final Question: "Who can stand?"
