Sermon Title: Two Gardens, Two Graves, One Hope – John 20:1-8

- I. Jesus destroys the dishonesty of the First Garden
 - Our deceit is forged on our PREFERENCES "God's choices must match mine if he really is God."
 - Our deception is founded on our <u>OPINIONS</u> "My opinions must be right because I'm so well informed. God must agree with me to be God."
 - · Our dishonesty is formed by our UNDERSTANDINGS "God must be understandable on my terms in order for me to accept his rule."
