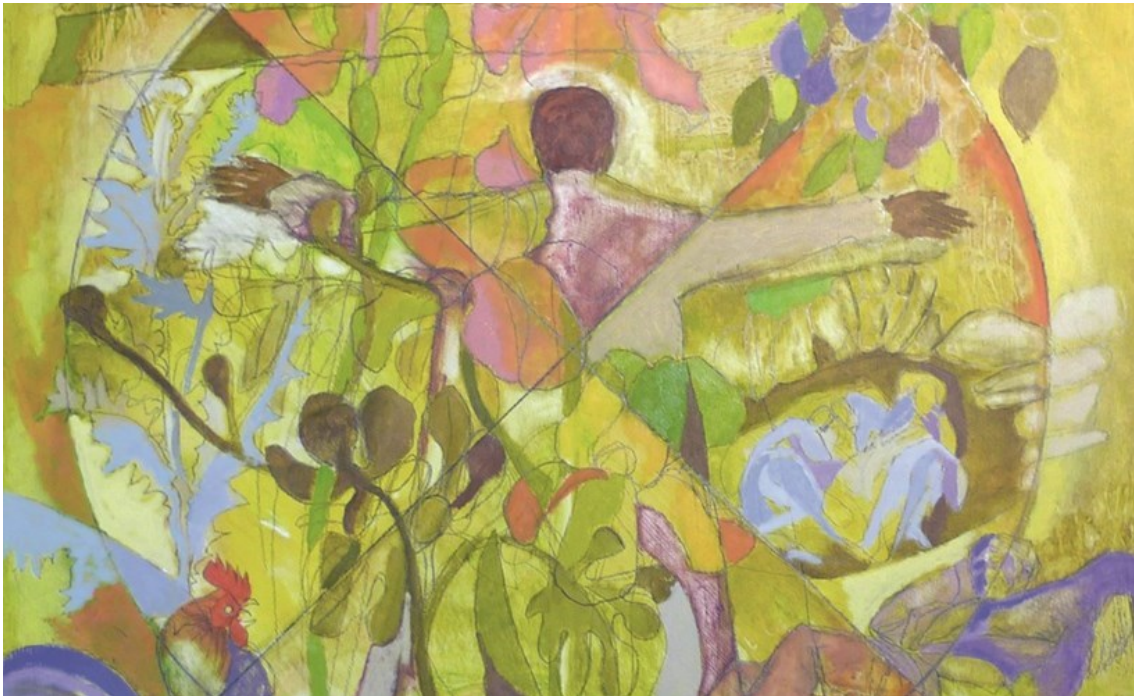

Holy Lord, as we enter this Lenten season, we are reminded of our weakness and our need for your strength.


We ask your forgiveness when we succumb to the temptations of this world, when we tread paths that are contrary to your will.
