Question 1 What one thing do you pursue in life with the greatest passion—your vision for life?

Question 2 What situations have you found yourself in where courage was required, and why was courage needed?

EQUIP | DIVE INTO GOD'S WORD

Question 3 What are some of the

benefits described in Proverbs 29 from living a righteous life (v. 2-4, 6-7)? What are the consequences for living unrighteously (e.g., v. 8-12, 22-24)?

Question 4 How would you summarize the theme of verses 29:4, 7, and 14?

Question 5 How would you summarize the theme of verses 28:28 and 29:2, 12? Why is character so important in leadership?

Question 6 In Proverbs 29:18, the word "vision" is translated in various Bibles as prophetic vision, revelation, guidance from God's law, word from God, and divine vision. How does knowing this add to your understanding of this verse?

Question 7 What happens to society when people throw off all restraint?

Question 8 Why did the Apostle Paul think it was important to check his vision, even though he had served the Lord for more than 14 years? (Galatians 2:1, 2)

Question 9 Read Philippians 1: 9-11. How does Paul summarize the outcome of living out Proverbs 29:18?

Question 10 How will you place Jesus in the center of your vision? How will this impact your relationship with your family? With Calvary church?

Question 11 Corporations are careful to set "a vision" for their business. How is this different from a vision from God for his church? In what ways is a church different from a business?
