II. THE SOBERING EFFECT OF

IT'S CALLED <u>REBELLION</u>.

The crew's <b>RESPONSE</b> to their <b>3 LEVELS</b>
of <b>FEAR</b> :
• Level 1: The mariners were afraid (v. 5)
> CLARITY comes quickly
> <b>EVERYBODY</b> needs to do their part
> Parallel: Mark 4:35-41
> <b>SOMEONE</b> is to <b>BLAME</b> for this
> INTERROGATION begins

FEAR

	> <u>CONFESSION</u> comes
	> Rebellion <b>STILL CONTINUES</b>
	> Parallel: Acts 2:37-38
•	<b>Level 3</b> : The men feared the Lord exceedingly (v. 16)
III. HO	OW <u>FAR</u> IS TOO <u>FAR</u> ?
	Being held accountable for Jonah's disobedience was a cost that was too high (v. 14).
•	That "for them" would have been too far.
•	How far has God been willing to go for you?
•	How far are you willing to go with Him today?
NOT	<b>ES</b>

• Level 2: they were exceedingly afraid (v. 10)
