The History

Protestant Reformation (authority of Scripture alone) - Martin Luther — 1517

Predestination (God alone) — John Calvin - ~1530

Foreknowledge (human choice) — Jacob Arminius - ~1590

Rapid spread and great division — continues to be an issue
