I. The Announcement (Luke 1:5-66)

A. The Angel's Visit (vv. 1-24)

*And there appeared to him an **angel** of the Lord standing on the right side of the altar of incense.* Luke 1:11

B. The Arrival Ceremony (vv. 57-63)

*Now the time came for Elizabeth to give birth, and **she bore a son**.* Luke 1:57

II. The Song of a Father (Luke 1:67-79)

*And his father Zechariah was filled with the Holy Spirit and prophesied, saying, "Blessed be the Lord God of Israel, for he has **visited** and **redeemed** his people"* Luke 1:67-68

A. A Song of a Promise (vv.69-75)

"to show the mercy promised to our fathers . . ." Luke 1:72a

B. A Song of a Preparation (vv. 76-77)

*"And you, child, will be called the prophet of the Most High; for you will go before the Lord to **prepare** his ways,"* Luke 1:76

C. A Song of a Peace (vv. 78-79)

*" . . . to guide our feet into the way of **peace**."* Luke 1:79b
