WHAT WILL HAPPEN TO THOSE HYGIENE KITS? Last Sunday, sixty people came to The Gathering Place at Pender to make UMCOR hygiene kits, and in under an hour and a half, we assembled almost 840! Special thanks to Greg, Maya, Steve, and Saundra, for leading this event! Pastor Will will take the kits to the 240th session of the Virginia Annual Conference in Hampton, Virginia. There, he will add them to kits from 1,100 other United Methodist Churches, which will then be loaded aboard tractor trailers headed to UMCOR's "Sager Brown" supply depot in Baldwin, Louisiana. Sager Brown is close to the port of New Orleans and the Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport, where our kits can be shipped out at a moment's notice. They could end up halfway across the world, or in your own back yard.
