I have been baptized in the Name of the Triune God, and have received instruction concerning the essence and significance of Holy Communion. 1 Corinthians 11:27-29

I am a sinner in need of forgiveness, repent of that sin, and have put my faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord over my life. I desire to grow in trust, obedience and faithfulness to Him. 1 John 1:6-9

I believe in the real presence of Christ's body and blood in the physical elements of bread and wine, and in the promise that they are given "for many for forgiveness of sins." Matthew 26:26-29

Because God has forgiven me, I am seeking to be at peace with my brothers and sisters in Christ. If I am struggling with sinful actions or attitudes, I am receiving Christ's presence and strength through this Sacrament to resolve them.
