All Daughters Banquet May 10 - 6 PM

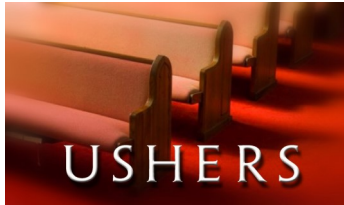

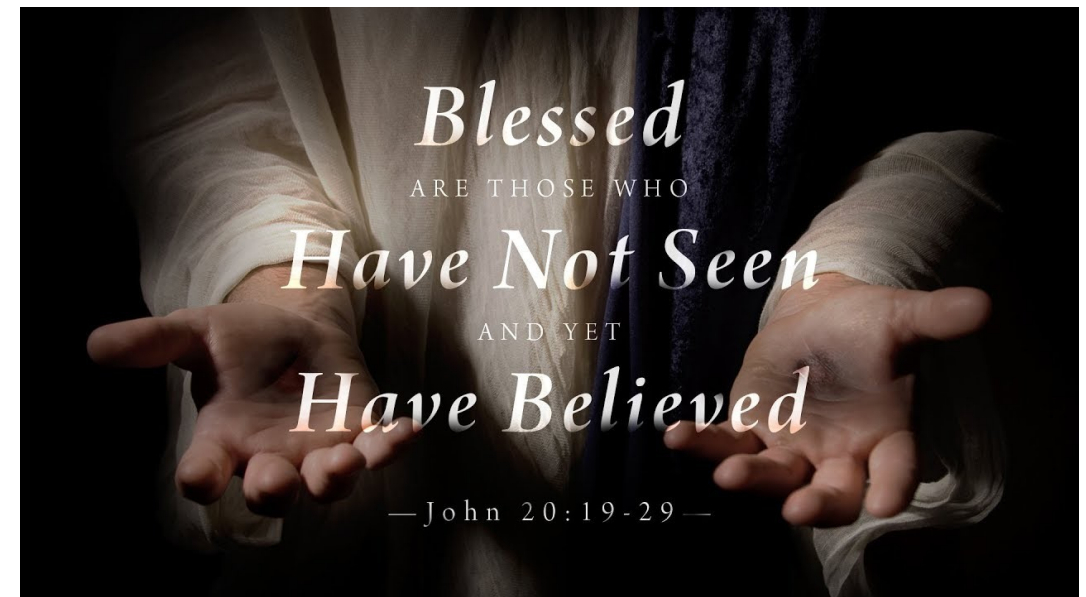
