Mother's Day

My mother moved into the home of a friend temporarily because the friend needed help after a medical crisis. She is preparing meals, washing clothes, and cleaning the house. She is happy to be busy and useful as an octogenarian, still in perpetual motion.

I can see her doing these things. I just replay the tapes from my childhood. Her hair was brown and curly then. Her skin was tan from the hours she spent working outside. The wringer washing machine was in the back yard. She pulled the clothes from the tub, fed them through the wringer, and carried the heavy baskets to the clothesline.

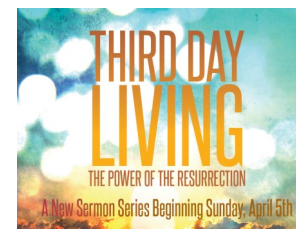
I never considered the difficulty of her work when I was a boy. I look back now and marvel at this woman who cared for all the food and clothing needs of a dozen people every day—including infant and toddler care. Her teenage boys gave meager help.

The servant heart is its own reward. A life turned outward to others is more interesting, always useful, seldom sullen or bitter, satisfying despite the difficulties and surprises of life.

Jesus picked up the towel during that Last Supper with his friends. He washed their feet. Jesus also taught that the Father in Heaven would put on the garb of the servant at the great banquet in heaven one day and serve us.

These women who care for us from the cradle to the grave—they are truly wonderful. They carry us through our helpless, hapless years (pretty much our entire life span). They are the face of God to us.
