

Administrative Board Meeting - The Administrative Board met Tuesday July 12th. There were nine members present along with Pastors Keith and Liz.

The General fund balance at the end of June was \$117,529. This is down some from the previous month. We are up to date on all District and Conference Apportionments.

Pastor Liz will be The Camp Manager for the upcoming Day Camp. The Board approved paying her for filling this position after Eagle Lake was unable to come this year. Pastor Liz has been instrumental in making this year's camp possible.

We are moving toward having a Media Host for the online service. This will enable us to have live interaction with worshipers attending the Online Service. There will be some expense to this process because server time has to be rented. A Digital Coordinator position will need to be created.

Major Repairs are being made to the Church by Septagon Contractors. The Trustee's will bring the Congregation information on the work being done. The repairs will cost about \$95,000 dollars. Much of this is being paid for from the Trustee's Maintenance Fund which can be contributed to anytime by earmarking the money you contribute. Some money has been raised specifically for this project, and the balance will come from the General Fund.

The Board voted to use up to \$20,000 from the General Fund to help pay for these repairs, with additional funding possibly needed by the time the project is completed.

There will be a tailgate party September 18th. It will take place after the first Service. The Journey Service will go on as normal and worshippers are welcome to bring food and drinks to the service.

A Woman's retreat is being planned for this fall.

The Four Strategic Goals we have are being developed. This fall is the timetable to start to implement them. Pastor Liz will be getting a new Job Description from the PPR committee to Develop and Implement the number 4 Spiritual Formation Pathway Goal.

Pastor Keith will be on vacation the first two weeks of August.
