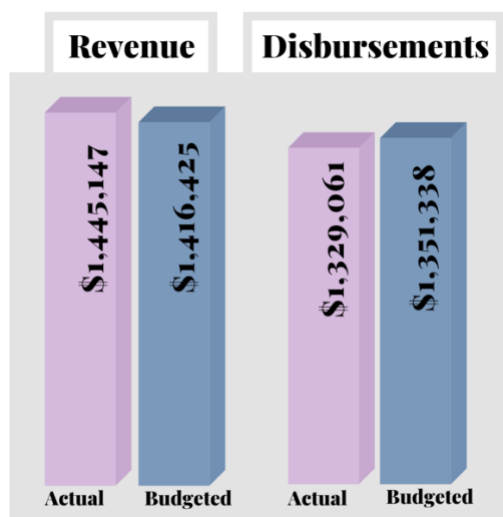

Financial Summary

Receipts were above budget by \$29,000 due to strong preschool tuition receipts. Expenses were below budget by \$22,000 mainly due to some mission and outreach programs being deferred to the second part of the year.
