Coram Deo Kids Wellness Policy

Thank you for allowing us to care for and teach your children each week. We would like to do everything we can to keep a healthy and safe environment for your child.

One way for you to help us and other families is by complying with our health guidelines.

Parents are asked not to bring their child to Coram Deo Kids Children's Ministry if one or more of the following conditions exist:

- Temperature of 100 degrees or higher in the last 24 hours
- Chills
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Severe abdominal pain
- Severe coughing
- Colored nasal drainage
- Runny nose accompanied by other symptoms
- Pink eye or another eye infection
- Head lice
- Rash
- Sore throat
- Croup
- RSV (Respiratory Syncytial Virus)
- COVID-19
- Skin infections or open skin lesions boils, ringworm, impetigo
- Any childhood disease (i.e. measles, mumps, rubella, chicken pox, whooping cough, etc.)
- Any infectious disease
- Ear pain or earaches
- Hand, foot, and mouth disease
- Rotavirus
- Difficulty breathing or untreated wheezing

If a child arrives to class and appears to be sick or tells a Coram Deo Kids leader or staff member that they have been sick in the last few hours, we will immediately contact the child's parents/caregiver, and the child must be removed from the children's ministry area.

A child must be free of fever, vomiting, or any other symptoms for <u>AT LEAST 24 hours</u>. If they are on antibiotics, they should be on the drug for <u>AT LEAST 24 hours</u> before coming to church.

Prevention of the Spread of Infection

- Please take your child to the bathroom/ change their diaper and wash their hands prior to checking them into Coram Deo Kids.
- Hand sanitizer is available in each classroom and the Check-In Desk for parents, volunteers, and children to use on a consistent basis.
- Coram Deo Kids Leaders in all classrooms will wash their hands prior to entering any classroom or interacting with any children.
- Coram Deo Kids Leaders will disinfect all toys and teaching environments after each service.
- Coram Deo Facilities Staff will sanitize all classrooms with an electrostatic sprayer that disinfects Influenza A & B, COVID-19, Norovirus, Rotavirus, and more. 99.9% of coronavirus and flu viruses.
- If your child is sick, please take him/her home. If a sickness is discovered after you drop off your child, you will receive a text message alerting you to return to the children's Check-In Desk.

Nursery Specific

- All toys will be cleaned and disinfected after each service.
- All bedding will be changed after each use and washed at the end of each day.
- All diaper changing stations will be disinfected after each changing; diapers will be disposed of in a closed container, and all Coram Deo Kids Leaders will wash their hands or use latex-free safety gloves.
- All leaders will remove shoes prior to serving in the nursery (or cover their shoes with disposable booties). Crawl mats and floor mats will not be walked on by any leaders.
- All floor mats are disinfected between services.
- Burp cloths are not shared between babies and are immediately washed following services.
