A note from Pastor Karla...

I always look forward to the Fall because of the change in rhythms of our life together. While Summer affords time for fun and travel, it is the Fall which beckons us to go inward, to evaluate our lives, and look deeper at what God is doing in us and through us. A more thoughtful look is what we will be doing this school year as a church centered on our new theme:

Look Deeper: Unearthing our Collective Soul.



These past months there has been one question that has been haunting my waking hours and that question is "Where are you?" This is the question God posed to Adam in the garden in Genesis 3 after Adam had eaten the forbidden fruit. Following this act of disobedience, Adam saw the world differently than he had previously and this made him want to hide. His eyes being "opened" made him aware of his distance from Eve, his distance from the garden, and ultimately his distance from God. That is what sin does in

Session Highlights August 31, 2022

There have been six major building campaigns in PLCPC history. During the August 31 meeting, the Session committed to starting the seventh campaign by approving Renovation Task Force Chair John Brand's motion "to renovate existing and build new preschool and children's education facilities and playground, and install an elevator." The Session marked this milestone with a prayer of thanksgiving, and heartfelt appreciation for the dedication and faithfulness of the RTF over the last three years.

In order to accomplish these goals, the Session further approved an agreement with The Steier Group development company, to assist in a capital campaign.

Brand reported on renovation presentations already made for the church staff, and announced a series of presentations to be made available for the congregation's viewing and discussion.

our lives as well, it distances us from relationships and makes us want to hide. But instead of God condemning Adam in this act, which God had every right to do, God posed a question, "Where are you?".

In our layered disobedience, that is the same question God poses to us today.

Sin sends us into an identity crisis and we don't know who we are anymore--worse, we have lost our sense of belonging. Our world, both those inside the church and outside the church, are in a crisis of identity and God invites us to answer the question together, "Where are you?" For some of us that means taking a deeper look into our lifestyles, for others it means looking deeper into our purpose, and still for others it means taking a closer look at our alignment with God and God's Church.

Where are you?

May this question haunt you as it has me in this season and may God help us answer its call.



RENOVATION OF OUR CHURCH

Session is pleased to announce, upon the recommendation of the Renovation Task Force (RTF), their unanimous approval of a motion to move forward with renovation of the preschool, playground and installation of an elevator.

When we renovated the Sanctuary in 2011-12, we made the commitment to focus our next renovation on the preschool and children's areas. To maximize this investment in our infrastructure, the RTF devised a plan which keeps the entire campus and all ministries in mind for the next 20-50 years. The Master Plan affords us many great campus-wide options to meet more needs for future generations, without compromising or reworking the structures we build in the near term.

Although the Covid pause halted us moving forward with our capital campaign in 2020, it also enabled us to come to this point with excellent improvements to the plan, for example, filling the need for open-air community gathering spaces, improving Children's play areas, upgrading overall security and safety, easier wayfinding and better flow, and addressing accessibility throughout the campus.
