SCC is offering an exciting opportunity to go on a MISSION TRIP this fall! It will be Sunday, October 9 through Wednesday, October 13, 2022 (over Speedway School's Fall Break). We will be going to Princeton, Kentucky to help the community continue to climb out of the wreckage left by the tornado outbreak that devastated much of western Kentucky in December 2021.

The trip will be intergenerational, including youth and adults. Our Chi-Rho youth (grades 6-8) and some adults will be working in the community garden of First Christian Church in Princeton and with their vegetable delivery service. Our CYF youth (grades 9-12) and other adults will be working to rebuild and repair houses with Habitat for Humanity.

We will be staying at First Christian Church in Princeton, KY. In order to assist with the tornado relief efforts, the church has created facilities where groups can stay in rooms with bunkbeds, showers, meeting rooms, etc.

The trip will cost \$125, which will include lodging, meals, transportation, and all materials needed for the work. Individuals may bring additional spending money if they would like, but it is not necessary.

We will have a meeting for all those interested on Sunday, August 28 at 9:15 a.m. and during youth group at 6:30 p.m. that evening.
