

Sermon Discussion Guide August 14, 2022

Refresh

Read Esther 9:1-10:3 to get the Scripture passage back in your mind.

Discuss

In Esther, we have seen a great reversal of circumstances. What are some of the reversals we see, and how do those reversals point to the reversals we experience spiritually in Christ?

Why might it be important to remember that our perspective is never the fullness of how God is working? How should this encourage us when we cannot see God's working in our lives?

How does this passage highlight the power of God in delivering His people? In what ways has God delivered you?

In verse 16, we read that the Jews "got relief from their enemies." In what ways has God given you relief in your life?

Why is it important to remember the deliverance God has given us? What are some ways we can keep this regularly before us?

Why do we tend to shy away from "obligations"? Why is it good to have the right obligations? What are eternal obligations that believers should be committing ourselves to? How can we lead our families in these obligations?
