1. Your perspective of your <u>pain</u> determines its purpose in your life

James 1:2

James 1:1

God introduces <u>trials</u> for your growth; your fleshly lusts bait you with <u>temptation</u> for your destruction.

Your perspective is your <u>responsibility</u>.

2. Your faith will not be **productive** until it's tested

James 1:3

Biblically, faith is defined as <u>trusting</u> God with what you can't see.
