thesaurus - that which is of exceptional value and kept <u>safe</u>, storehouse of treasures

What does it mean to "store up treasures in heaven"?

 to invest your life in what will last and in what will be rewarded - Paul calls it building with "fire proof" materials

3. Serve the right Master

Matthew 6:24

It's not just that God is helping us to distinguish what will last and what will not, but He is objecting to <u>idolatry</u> – to your elevation of anything else above His rightful place in your life.

"A man may work for two employers, but since 'single ownership and full time service are of the essence of slavery,' he cannot serve two slave owners. Either God is served with single-eyed devotion or He is not served at all. Attempts at divided loyalty betray not partial commitment to discipleship, but a deep-seated commitment to idolatry."
