1. Kingdom seekers are joyfully ready to invest <u>everything</u> for what is to be gained

Matthew 13: 44-46

Is there anything that has so much <u>value</u> to you that you've been willing to invest everything to have it?

The Greek word here translated as "hate" can mean that of strong distaste or full rejection, but it's a word of comparison that many commentators see better understood as "to <u>renounce</u> one choice in favor of another"

As the people in your relational worlds watch you live like Jesus really is the found treasure, they will notice that you haven't just "added Him" to your agendas and life, but that you truly are His follower who values Him above everything else

3. When you know how it all ends, investing yourself in Jesus makes more <u>sense</u> than any other option
