1. You know what love is when you understand how God loves you

agape: seeking others' well-being while expecting nothing in return

1 John 4:9-10

2. Once you receive God's love, you realize it's meant to give away

1 John 4:11-12

The invisible God becomes visible when we love each other the way that He's loved us

John 13:34-35

The primary purpose of your small group is to build community not to complete a study

3. You give away love best when you're "nearby"

The Greek word that we translate as "neighbor" and the actual English word itself mean "a near dweller"

If you don't have an answer for where you presently are engaging the command to "love one another," then there is a foundational piece missing to your obedience to Jesus and there's something you can do about it today
