It is 5:53 on Wednesday morning. The crew at CBTV are in the studio, preparing for their first news broadcast of the day.

- Suzi: [Sleepily] Hey, could someone get me a coffee, please? These early shows are so difficult for me. I need to start doing the morning news.
- Simon: [Hands Suzi a coffee] Here, drink this quickly, Suzi. You are on the air in ... six minutes.
 - Suzi: Thanks Simon. What are our top stories this morning?
- Simon: The usual a car accident, an increase in taxes ...
 - Suzi: So nothing "new" about the news today.
- Simon: No, not really [Simon's phone rings. He picks it up.]

Simon: Hello?

- Lucie: Simon, it's Lucie. This is urgent! There is a guy on the Champlain Bridge **threatening** to jump off! The police are on their way and traffic is starting to back up this is a major story!
- Simon: Lucie, that's great! Do you have a camera crew there? We will need some video.

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anchorwoman = the person who "hosts" the television news

threaten = to announce an intention to do something

lead =
the main story title
cop =

a policeman

footage = video images

Simon: No problem! [He hangs up.]

Simon: Suzi, there is a change in headlines – the new story **lead** is, "Suicide Jumper" – get ready to – [the phone on Simon's desk rings again].

Simon: Hello?

- Brad: Simon, this is Brad. I am on Boulevard des Forges a bomb just went off in a building down here. There are **cops** everywhere and they are clearing the area.
- Simon: Wow! Great story! Do you have any video?
- Brad: Karl is taping as we speak. Karl?
- Karl: [speaks into the phone] Simon, I have video of the smoke coming out of the building, the **cops** on the scene, I have people on the street looking scared ...
- Simon: That sounds great! Brad, find a few people to interview. Try to get them to talk about how they feel if you can. We want as much emotion as possible. People love that stuff.
