| | From two to six years. |
| | From 6 to 10 years. |
| | From 10 to 18 years. |
| | From 18 to about 70 years. |
| | From about 70 years to death. |

| Stage | Characteristics |

| a) Adolescence | Major growth; learning through games and socialization. |
| b) Adulthood | Brain development and great physical growth; learns to walk; learns language. |
| c) Baby | 3. Physical growth slows; movements more coordinated. |
| d) Childhood | Sexual characteristics develop; last growth spurt. |
| e) Early childhood | 5. Gradual decrease in muscle mass and physical strength. |
| f) Old age | 6. Stage of maturity; very productive period. |
