### How To Wear Ceylon Yellow



Warm and Exotic

Ceylon Yellow is located on the soft color wheel under the Yellow Orange label.

It is a warm color, which means that if you have cool undertones, this color will likely not flatter you.

I'll be using the soft color wheel, but it's ok if you use the BRIGHT color wheel. Ceylon Yellow is somewhere between bright and soft. You can wear this color with your brighter colors too.


Warm and Exotic


Ceylon Yellow is a warm, bold and exotic color. The more Ceylon Yellow in your outfit the more warm, bold and exotic you will appear.

The less of the color, the less warm, bold and exotic. So, if you love the color, but just want a little of it, pop it in with accessories, or cover it up with a jacket or cardigan.


