



Reminders of Contact Information for School Closures or Emergencies

Mooreville Schools administration and staff will always do our best to alert families via school email or other systems in the event of an emergency at one of our schools; however, power outages or other catastrophic events could disrupt our ability to send parent emails/texts/phone calls as quickly as we would like. For this reason, we encourage families to sign up for additional free alerts via local media as well. We believe it's better for families to be informed in as many ways as possible if a school closure or other emergency occurs. Please consider utilizing one or all of the following:

- Ch. 59 (www.wxix.com) – allows subscribers to get alerts for specific counties & school systems
- Ch. 8 (www.wishtv.com) - allows subscribers to get alerts for specific counties & school system
- Ch. 13 (www.wthr.com) – allows subscribers to sign up for breaking news alerts via website or apps
- Ch. 6 (www.theindychannel.com) – allows subscribers to sign up for breaking news alerts via website or apps
- The Reporter-Times (www.reporter-times.com) – sends local news alerts and closings (newspaper subscription required)

We are also able to remotely access our Facebook page (www.Facebook.com/MoorevilleSchools) and website (www.MoorevilleSchools.org) and will update those whenever possible in the case of a school closure or other emergency situation.

Also, please remember that it is very important that your child's school receives updated information if your phone number or email changes. This is important for situations as simple as a child becoming sick at school. You may have multiple emails, contact people, and telephone numbers on your child's contact information as you see fit, such as including a grandparent's or babysitter's email if you do not have a personal email.

Please be aware that the primary contact emails and cellular telephone numbers listed will receive school emails or text messages. As an example, all contacts will receive alerts that report cards are ready for online viewing; however, other those with Harmony passwords will be able to access that information.
