



Swindle Steps Down from Mooresville Board

Mooresville, Ind. –Matt Swindle will be stepping down from the Mooresville Schools Board of Directors effective June 12, 2013. Swindle, who represents the Town of Mooresville and currently serves as vice president of the board, will be moving to Texas where his wife has accepted a job and they can move to be nearer family.

“I have enjoyed the opportunity to have served and to tell all the Mooresville School Community how much I admire the dedication, the selflessness and the overall hard work of all of the school employees,” said Swindle. “I have met so very many good people while in this position and will always cherish those memories.”



Per board policy and Indiana Code, Swindle’s replacement will be chosen by the remaining board members. The person chosen will fill the remainder of Swindle’s term and the position will be up for re-election in November 2014.

Those interested in serving in Swindle’s position must be residents of the Town of Mooresville, be over age 18 and have no felony convictions. Interested applicants should submit a letter of interest and resume postmarked by Wednesday, June 19 to Dr. Bill Roberson, c/o Law Offices of Harris and Currens, 9 W. Main St., Mooresville, IN 46158 or they may be hand-delivered to the same address no later than 4:45p.m. on Friday, June 21, 2013.

The board will hold an executive session June 24 at 6p.m. for candidate interviews and a second session June 25 at 6p.m. to vote on the appointment. The new member will begin serving at the July 9, 2013 school board meeting.

“As a board we have strived to provide a stable financial platform from which students and staff alike will continue to benefit,” said Swindle. “With both the State and Federal government's unfunded mandates constantly bombarding the schools, this will be an ongoing battle to remain financially solvent. We have also worked to establish partnerships with all local entities, government, corporate and private to provide as much efficiency and cooperation as possible which will also provide opportunities to all in the community.”

The Board also includes representatives from Brown Township (Board President Dr. Bill Roberson), Madison Township (Mark Meadows), Harrison Township (Randy Davis), and At-Large (Board Secretary Perry King).

Swindle also serves as the representative for Mooresville Schools on the Mooresville Park and Recreation District Board. An elected member of the School Board will be chosen to fill that position as per the Park Board bylaws.
