



## Oberle Joins Moore'sville School Board



MOORESVILLE, Ind. – Dave Oberle has been appointed as the newest member of the Board of Directors of Moore'sville Consolidated School Corporation. Oberle was voted in to represent the Town of Moore'sville on the board in place of Matt Swindle, who is moving out of state.

To replace Swindle, the remaining board members held interviews with interested candidates and Oberle was chosen.
