




Mooresville Boys Basketball Program to Play at Bankers Life Fieldhouse

The Mooresville High School Athletic Department is pleased to announce the Pioneers boys basketball team will play against Edgewood High School at Bankers Life Fieldhouse. The game is part of the 2nd Hoosier Invitational, featuring 10 schools and 6 games.

The lineup of games will be held on Saturday, December 21, 2013 with Martinsville vs. Eastern Greene (boys) at 11:00 a.m., followed by Mooresville and Edgewood (boys) at 1:00 p.m., Westfield vs. Tipton (girls) at 2:45 p.m., Tipton vs. Westfield (boys) at 4:30 p.m., Oak Hill vs. Frankton (boys) at 6:15 and capping off the evening will be Mississinewa vs. Mt. Vernon (boys) at 8:00 p.m.

Children 2 and under are admitted free. One ticket is good for all five games that will be played December 21st at Bankers Life Fieldhouse. Pioneer fans are instructed to sit on the West side or opposite the player benches.
