



Mooresville Named “Outstanding School Board” by Indiana School Boards Association

For the second time, the Mooresville School Board has been recognized as “Outstanding” by the Indiana School Boards Association (ISBA).

The ISBA awards school boards based upon members’ participation in various activities, including participation in educational opportunities, serving on community boards, and presenting information to other school boards.



“Our Board of Education works extremely hard to provide the opportunities for our students to succeed academically, physically, and emotionally in a safe environment conducive to learning,” said Superintendent David Marcotte. “They continually focus on providing the appropriate resources to accomplish our goals.”

School board members and administrators from around the state, including representatives from the Mooresville Schools, attended the Indiana School Boards Association regional meeting on March 17 at The Inn at DePauw in Greencastle, Indiana. Local representatives attending were school board members Dr. Bill Roberson, Perry King, and Dave Oberle as well as Superintendent David Marcotte.

The ISBA is conducting meetings in each of its 10 regions across the state to discuss the effect the 2014 General Assembly will have on the operation of Indiana’s public schools.

The regional meetings are conducted through the month of May to acquaint board members and superintendents with newly enacted legislation. ISBA Executive Director and lobbyist, Dr. Frank Bush, presented the details of the newly enacted legislation affecting Indiana public education. David Emmert, Esq., ISBA General Counsel, delivered an update on legal issues. ISBA also requested suggestions from local board members for proposed legislation to be presented by the Legislative Committee to the Delegate Assembly during the 2014 ISBA/IAPSS Fall Conference held at the Indiana Convention Center in September. The ISBA is a non-profit organization with 288 members, including every public school board in the state.
