## Mooreville High School Trespassers Detained, Arrested

On Tuesday after school, two unidentified males entered MHS through a door which had been opened for a sports team. A school staff member immediately noticed the suspicious pair and contacted police. Through police searches and checks of the school camera system, the two were located after they had exited the building and taken into custody.

Examination of video footage showed the pair walking through the building and exiting a door on the opposite side of the school two minutes later. Police detained both individuals and discovered one of them was listed on the sex offender registry. Felony charges have been filed against that individual.

“This is a perfect example of our community working together,” said Mooreville Police Chief Danny Allen. “Our officers cannot be everywhere at once but we have eyes and ears all over the community to let us know what is happening and help us be more effective.”

“We are very thankful for our staff member who reported suspicious individuals and contacted the police,” said Superintendent Dr. David Marcotte. “We are also thankful for the quick work of our Mooreville Police in apprehending the pair. We remind everyone visiting our schools that the adage ‘if you see something, say something’ is good practice.
