MOORESVILLE, Ind. – Amanda Miller and Stephanie Dockery have accepted the head boys and girls varsity swimming coaching position at Mooresville High School. Miller and Dockery will be associate head coaches who will run both varsity programs together.

“We look forward to Amanda and Stephanie leading our swimming programs,” said Mooresville Athletic Director Chad Briscoe. “The approach to having two head coaches to lead both our swimming programs only enhances the experience for our student athletes. Both coaches have an extensive background in swimming. Miller has served as the varsity boys and girls assistant coach at Mooresville since 2007. She has served as the Paul Hadley Middle School head coach since 2008 and will continue to serve as the middle school head coach going forward.

Miller was a standout swimmer at Connersville High School where she served as team captain and received the mental attitude award. She competed in the Butterfly, Individual Medley and Medley Relay. She also holds a Black Belt in TaeKwonDo and serves as a teacher at Paul Hadley Middle School.

“Both Amanda and Stephanie will be great coaching additions on our swimming programs,” said MHS Principal Chuck Muston. “I am confident that they both will continue to build our swimming programs and impact the lives of our student athletes.”

Dockery was an all-state swimmer at Mt. Vernon High School. She placed in the state meet three years in a row during her high school career. Dockery’s success earned her a full ride scholarship to swim at the University of Kentucky, where she still holds records in the 100 yard Breaststroke and the 200 and 400 Medley Relay teams.

Dockery was a USS swimmer from 1989 to 1997 and was a senior National qualifier at Ft. Lauderdale, FL in 1994. She coached the Roper Mountain Estates summer SAIL team in Greenville, South Carolina in 2005 and 2007. This past year Dockery taught at Neil Armstrong Elementary School.
