Class of 2018 Graduates 335

The Class of 2018, led by Valedictorian Teehan Raymond and Salutatorian Garrett Sanders, ended their MHS careers with commencement Saturday. MHS Principal Dr. Brian Disney honored the graduates for many achievements during their time at MHS. His remarks included:

- 53 of our seniors were awarded \$3.5 million in scholarships to 30 colleges and 23 other awards.
- 84 graduates have been recognized for their character, service, and academics as members of National Honor Society.
- More than 40% of our graduates have earned an Academic Honors or Technical Honors Diploma, maintaining at least a "B" average while taking a more rigorous course load including additional math, science, and world language courses. These students also earned college credits and/or industry certifications while enrolled at MHS. These seniors were also leaders in athletic and extracurricular activities, including:

A community preschool class will be added at Waverly Elementary this fall during normal school hours. Students must be age 4 by Aug. 1. Enrollment will be on a first-come, first-served basis and is open to families who reside in the Mooresville school district area or who already have students attending Mooresville Schools. - State Finalist groups and teams were the Winter Guard, Pioneer Regiment, Competitive Cheer, Percussion Ensemble, and English Academic Team while individual State Finalists were honored in wrestling, boys' diving, girls' tennis, and girls' track.
- During their four years at MHS, these seniors were leaders on Mid-State Conference Championship teams in wrestling, boys' and girls' basketball, girls' tennis and academic teams. Additionally, MHS won the first 2 Mid-State Championships in Unified Track, our softball team won 4 consecutive Mid-State Championships, and several athletes from this class were named Mid-State All-Conference and Academic All-Conference.
- Our students have also been servant leaders, contributing hundreds of hours of community service including volunteering with many local school and community groups and raising money for many great causes including Relay for Life and Special Olympics Champions Together.
- MHS once again won the IHSA and Special Olympics' Champions Together Award."

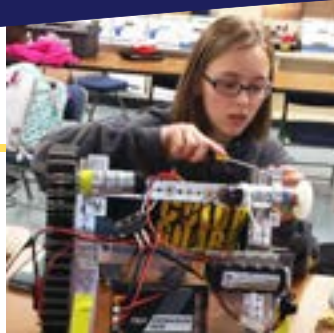
