## Mooreville Schools eLearning Plan for 2019-2020

Yesterday Dr. Jennifer McCormick, Indiana Superintendent of Public Instruction, announced the closure of all Indiana K-12 schools through the end of the school year. To say that we are saddened by this announcement is an understatement, but we know that the safety of our students, staff, and community is the most important priority at this time.

Our eLearning plan will be similar throughout the end of the school year. We are committed to working with our students and continuing their education as best we can. We are also committed to continuing our meal program for families in need. As a reminder, there will be no state standardized testing this spring (no ISTEP, ILEARN, IREAD, IAM, and ISPROUT).

We know this announcement creates many questions. Please know that we are going to work with our administrators and staff to find the best solutions available given the circumstances and with guidance from the Indiana Department of Education. Additional details, including updates to graduation qualifications and class requirements, will be forthcoming. We appreciate all of the hard work of our teachers with eLearning lessons and the support of our families as you keep your children, our students, engaged in learning through these uncharted circumstances.

Please be aware that our schools, playgrounds, and athletic facilities will also remain closed for the remainder of the school year beyond essential services such as our food service program. We ask that our families continue to check for district messages and visit [MoorevilleSchools.org](https://www.moorevilleschools.org) for updates.

Please take care of yourselves. Stay at home following CDC guidelines, practice social distancing when you cannot remain at home, wash your hands frequently, and stay healthy. Pioneers paved the way for this nation through difficult times, and our Pioneer spirit is still strong. ### **Beginning Monday, April 6**

**Grades K-6:** Students will continue to utilize eLearning on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday of each week that we are closed. We will utilize waiver days from the state on Mondays and Tuesdays for teachers to prepare eLearning lessons for the week. Students will continue using Google Classroom for their lessons as they have this week. Offline learning packets may be requested each week by calling your child's school and leaving a request message (dial "0" when you make the call and leave the message on the secretary's voicemail account) by 6:00pm on Tuesdays each week. These packets will be available *at your child's elementary school each week on Wednesdays from 10:00am-noon*. This will be the **only time** packets will be distributed each week. Previous week's packets may be turned in at that time as well.

**Grades 7-12:** Students will continue to utilize eLearning on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday of each week that we are closed. We will utilize waiver days from the state on Mondays and Tuesdays for teachers to prepare eLearning lessons for the week. Students will continue using Canvas for their lessons as they have this week.

**All Students:** Teachers will continue to be available for assistance via email and Google Classroom/Canvas from 9:00am to noon Wednesday – Friday each week.
