Conclusion and Recommendations:

Water infiltration at windows' was determined to be mainly from exterior caulking which has failed over time; measures have been taken to repair the windows exterior caulking and eliminate the water infiltration. Sills to be removed and replaced prior to school start.

Mould growth on duct coverings is caused by blowing snow in winter which enters plenum through grilles and melts, causing staining. Custodian asked to monitor and wipe area if any mould growth occurs.

Stained tiles in Biology 1102 determined to be from floor scrubber when washing floors and water entered the lab stations' floor penetrations from Chemistry Room above. Recommended that base of lab stations to be caulked to restrict water from entering floor penetration. Once completed, stained tiles to be replaced. This work is scheduled to be complete prior to school start.

Faculty and staff are asked to report any signs of water infiltration and/or mould to their Property Services Manager so that water infiltration is repaired and any mould which may have developed is remediated right away.
