

Behavior Policy

At Camp _____, we strive to maintain a safe environment and ensure that each camper fully enjoys their time at camp. As a result, our leadership takes all incidents of unacceptable behavior very seriously and trains our staff to recognize and effectively handle such behavior.

Campers and parents are required to read and sign our Camper Code of Conduct, agreeing to follow the guidelines developed for our camp program. Any behavior deemed inappropriate and/or unmanageable by the Camp Director may result in any or all of the following:

- Verbal warning
- Time out
- The Camp Director will meet with the parent/guardian to discuss behavior and consequences
- Dismissal from camp for the day
- Expulsion from camp program

As a Camper, I will:

- Show respect to campers: treat them as well as I would like to be treated and try to be a friend to all.
- Show respect to camp staff and cooperate fully with their instructions.
- Communicate in an appropriate manner, which means I must not use foul language or gestures, harsh words or tone of voice.
- Conduct myself responsibly: I understand that horseplay, unwelcome teasing or other unkind and bullying behaviors will not be tolerated.
- Refrain from deliberately causing bodily harm to other campers or staff. I understand that pushing/shoving, kicking, hitting/fighting, biting and spitting are not acceptable under any circumstances.
- Respect the beliefs of others and treat them with courtesy and consideration.
- Use program equipment, supplies and facilities properly and responsibly.
- Respect the property of others: I will not steal, damage or vandalize any property.
- Be fully responsible for my actions, and understand that irresponsible behavior will result in disciplinary action or dismissal from camp.
- Know and follow the rules of the camp.
- Not leave camp property unless on a supervised outing.
- Be on time for all camp activities.
