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MBE and DBE Contracting Overview

- Currently, MTA has over 400 active contracts, with a total award value of \$6.7 billion
- Minority Business Enterprises (MBE) state goal for FY 25 is 29%.
- Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) goal for FY23-25 is 30%
 - Most recent reporting period, DBEs represented
 39.41% of contracts awarded
- All solicitations are reviewed by MTA's
 Procurement Review Group (PRG) to evaluate
 and determine the MBE/DBE goals based on
 market analysis

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

DBE and MBE Programs

- MTA has long been committed to fostering economic growth through programs that uplift minority and disadvantaged firms.
- LRMP aims to enhance the state's public transportation system and to ensure that minority/disadvantaged-owned, and small businesses have a fair chance to thrive in the process.
- Funding for the program is sourced from both state and federal budgets, with a significant portion allocated to DBE participation.





Doing Business with MTA

The Maryland Department of Transportation's (MDOT) Office of Minority Business Enterprise (OMBE) is Maryland's official certification agency for the MBE and DBE Programs.

CERTIFICATION

- Firms must be MBE and/or DBE certified.
- Firms must be certified for the NAICS (North American Industry Classification System) under the work to be performed.
- Certification must be current.
- Must be in good stand with the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation (DAT).



Working with MTA

 The state regularly publishes procurement opportunities related to the LRMP on its official websites and databases.



- DBEs are encouraged to monitor these platforms to identify and bid on contracts aligned with their expertise.
- Through strategic planning, effective partnerships, and robust support systems, MTA is paving the way for a brighter, more equitable future where DBEs play a central role in shaping the state's transportation landscape.

DBE Participation by Program 'Tranche'

No DBE Goal set by MTA

- Tranche 1: Replacing 52 Vehicles with modern Low Floor LRVs
 - o Transit Vehicle Manufacture (TVM) works directly with FTA

DBE Goals Tailored by Contract

- Tranche 1: Upgrading Signaling System
- Tranche 2: Upgrading 33 Stations to include Level boarding
- Tranche 3: Modernizing Cromwell MSF
- Tranche 4: Traction Power Station Upgrades
 Already advertised with a 5.41% goal
- Tranche 5: Modernizing North Avenue MSF

All tranches will be federally funded and will follow applicable federal DBE guidance.



LRMP Industry Classifications

DBEs can contribute to the program across several industries and sectors, including, but not limited to:

- Construction and Engineering
- Technology and Signaling Systems
- Environmental Services
- Supplier and Vendor Opportunities
- Professional Services



Labor Agreements: Governor's Executive Order

- Authorizing Project Labor Agreements for Large-Scale Public Work Contracts and Promoting Apprenticeship Agreements and Community Hiring
- Requires state agencies to consider including a PLA on a large-scale public works contract
- If it is determined that the project should have a PLA, the Executive Order specifies certain provisions that must be included in the PLA

MDOT is committed to abiding by this Executive Order, including for the Light Rail Modernization Program



Labor Agreements: LRMP

- Tranche 1: Replacing 52 Vehicles with modern Low Floor LRVs and Upgrading Signaling System
 - No Project Labor Agreement requirement expected
- Tranche 2: Upgrading 33 Stations to include Level boarding
 - Project Labor Agreement possible, feasibility study underway
- Tranche 3: Modernizing Cromwell MSF
 - Project Labor Agreement likely, feasibility study underway
- Tranche 4: Traction Power Station Upgrades
 - No Project Labor Agreement required

Tranche RFPs will detail all labor requirements.
