
CYMS A Men - Sunday "a while ago" Us Lots d Them Less than Lots

Should you wish to be considered for selection in the mens firsts, the mens seconds, or the team which will represent Melbourne Uni at the 1992 Australian Universities Championships (Intervarsity) you should attend as follows:

- (iii) Mens A.U.C. (I.V.) team...Mondays and Fridays.

It should also be noted that to be eligible for selection in the 1992 A.U.C. (I.V.) team you must either make yourself available to represent M.U.B.C. during the 1992 VBA championship season, or be competing at a higher than VBA division 2 standard.
