



## 2025 COACH CHECKLIST

## Prior to tournament weekend:

Register the team through the GYBA website (pay online or pay at venue). First come, first serv	<i>,</i> C
until we are full. Typically 10-12 teams per age group depending on field availability.	

- Generate my roster and make sure all kids are eligible as of April 30th 2026 for the age division I am registering. Example: a 10U player cannot be 11 before May 1st 2026. He must be 10 on April 30th 2026. Age groups are determined similar to that of league play. Make sure to have a copy of birth certificates on hand. If there is a challenge, the coach must be able to provide it. Challenges must be sent immediately to the tournament director after the game has completed. If a player is found to be ineligible, the game will be forfeited and the player disqualified from playing in that age division.
- Make sure I have insurance on my team. Select teams understand insurance and have it for their teams. All-Star and recreational level teams must obtain insurance from their respective league. For example, a GYBA team or group of current GYBA players are covered. A team or group of current RRYBL players will not be covered under GYBA policy. If you do not have coverage from your league association, you can purchase insurance from USSSA or Perfect Game online. Proof of team insurance is required to play in any baseball tournament including GYBA Blue Santa. Ask your league representative for a copy of their insurance policy. GYBA teams do not need to request a copy but must provide additional insurance if you have non-GYBA players.

## Tournament Weekend:

3rd base dugout.

Arrive about one hour before the game to provide a copy of the team roster, insurance and
registration fee (if not completed online). Tent will most likely be located near the field three and
four batting cages.
Deliver an unwrapped toy (\$20 value), preferably as a team, to the registration tent. The
Georgetown Police Department and Blue Santa representatives will be there to accept and take
pictures. Please tell your parents that they can donate more toys if they so choose. The \$20 is not a
maximum, remember what we are doing this for.
Play your games as scheduled. Be prepared for the schedule to be ahead or behind. Coin flip
determines home or away during pool play games.
Pool play results will be posted as soon as possible after the last game has concluded. Results from
pool play will be determined based on standard rules in the following order: Points (Two for a win,
one for a tie, and zero for a loss), Head to Head (thrown out if more than two teams involved),
Least Runs Allowed, Most Runs Scored, and Coin Flip by Tournament Director.
Bracket play on Sunday will have highest seed as Home team (one being the highest) located on the
