GYBA BLUE SANTA TOURNAMENT RULES

- The order of rules interpretations are as follows: these local rules, USSSA, MLB rules.
 Conflicts will be settled by the Umpire in Charge or Tournament Director.
- Coin flip for all pool play games to determine Home vs. Away for game play. Dugout placement on schedule.
- Pool play games can end in a tie. If Home team has a chance to win/tie game after time has expired, inning will be completed. If not, the game is over and score stands at point umpire calls game.
- Players without a jersey/number can still play. Coaches will work to identify each player on the roster.
- Roster size will be limited to 12 players per registered team.
- Coaches not occupying the field of play for their respective age groups are required to stay within arm's length of the dugout, on the porch.
- In 6U/8U, the player pitcher is to be behind or even with the pitching rubber, but with both feet inside the circle.
- Higher seed (one is higher than eight) is Home team in weekend bracket play.
- Full grain leather baseballs will be used and provided by the coaches.
 No RIFF balls or synthetic leather balls allowed.
- Arguing with an official, the use of profanity or the physical abuse of anyone on or off the field by a player,
 parent, coach or fan may be cause for ejection from the game/park. Failure to leave the GYBA complex may result in forfeiture of participation by the team associated with the ejected party.
- No head first slides, unless diving back to bag.

BRACKET PLAY SEEDING FROM POOL PLAY GAMES WILL BE BASED ON THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- 1. Points earned (two for a win, one for a tie, zero for a loss)
- 2. Head to head (thrown out if more than two teams are involved in the tie)
- 3. Total runs allowed (lower amount given up is higher seed)
- 4. Total runs scored (higher amount scored is higher seed)
- 5. Coin flip (best two out of three to be conducted by Tournament Director)

INNING LIMITATIONS AND RUN RULES

Innings & Time Limit: 8U (6 or 75 mins.) 9U, 10U, 11U, 12U (6 or 90 mins.) 14U (7 or 105 mins.)

Inning Run Limit: 8U, 9U, 10U (8 per inning) 11U, 12U (10 per inning) 14U (10 Saturday only)

Run Rule: 15 after 3, 10 after 4, and 8 after 5 for all age divisions

TIE BREAKER REGULATION

Texas Tie Breaker - start the new inning with one out, bases loaded. Place the offensive players as follows: hitter at the plate, prior player in the line-up at first base, next player at second base, and next player at third base.

All age divisions will play Texas Tie Breaker until there is a winner (Sunday only).

PITCHING LIMITATIONS AND RULES CLARIFICATION

9U & 10U PITCHES – daily max 75 pitches per player, 100 pitch maximum over two-day event.

11U & 12U PITCHES – daily max 85 pitches per player, 110 pitch maximum over two-day event.

14U PITCHES – daily max 95 pitches per player, 120 pitch maximum over two-day event.

THE PITCHER MUST BE REPLACED ON THE MOUND IMMEDIATELY UPON NOTICE OF A VIOLATION, NOT A FORFEIT.
