- **Junior** – under 16 as of Sept. 1, 2025
- **Intermediate** – under 17 as of Sept. 1, 2025
- **Senior** – under 19 as of Sept. 1, 2025

Guidelines

- Each individual athlete may be entered in only ONE event. (\$15/athlete)
- Each athlete must compete in the appropriate age bracket as described above.
- Schools can enter 3 athletes/teams for each category
 - A player may opt-up to play at an older level, but not a lower level.
- Athletic Directors, please make sure your coaches and student-athletes are familiar with the rules of the game.
- Game Format
 - Round robin matches with pool play. Games played to 21, capped at 23. Semi-Finals/Finals – one game to 15, capped at 21, win by 2
 - Second round will be play-off pool. Top 1 or 2 (depending on category size) move onto play-offs pools (2 total Pools)
 - Semi's and Finals. Top 2 from each playoff pool will play a crossover semi-final and winners play finals.
 - **Please note that scoring MAY be adjusted if needed due to time.**

- **RALLY POINT SCORING** shall be used, ensure your athletes know how to score a game.
- Ties are broken in the following order:
 1. If there are two teams tied a tie-break, win/loss vs each other will decide the winner
 2. If three or more teams are tied, the overall plus/minus accumulated by those players will be used.
 - A. Plus-minus within round-robin against the other tied teams (wins and points).
 - B. If needed, a sudden-death single game will be played between losers of a coin toss while winner gets a bye.

Etiquette

- Introduce each other before games.
- Spin a racquet/Toss a bird to determine the first server.
- Warm-ups will be limited to 1 minute.
- Calls are made by the player on the side that the bird landed.
- Call score before each serve.
- No practice play on the sidelines.
- Attire should reflect the school logo and/or colors. No club/corporate logos.
- Walk around the courts between rallies.
- Non-marking footwear
- Supply own racquet

Tournament Details:

- Athletes must be prepared to play their game when courts come open.
- In the case of a no-show, the game will be announced, and after 2 minutes, no-shows will forfeit.
- Leave the bird on the court after each game. New birds can be obtained from the supervisor's desk by turning in the old bird.
- Winners must record results on the score sheet immediately after the match.
- There is no coaching at any time during a game, the only time there can be coaching is between games
- If a conflict occurs during a match, the supervisor can assign a referee from another school.
- Protests after a match will not be entertained.
- First to fourth-place finishers will receive points toward the team banner.
- Shuttles: We will use Mavis 300 green band birds with yellow skirts or something similar.

We ask that all schools help to supervise the courts to ensure games go smoothly and run on time.
