



Tournament Rules

1. Ages

Girls 14 & under for 14U as of January 1, 2015

Girls 16 & under for 16U as of January 1, 2015

2. Tournament Governed by ASA Rule book 2015.

- Pool Play Games: All players on the roster are allowed to bat. 9 in the field.
- Elimination Games: Bat 9 only, DP/Flex allowed.
- Helmets, Bats, Balls - ASA approved with NOCSAE label. Face masks and chin straps required.

3. Prior to Game:

- Warm-ups will take place in the designated areas on the map. Please stay off the infield of the baseball fields.
- Be at the field at least 15 minutes prior to your game.
- Exchange line ups. Home team official book.
- Infield warm-up behind 2nd and 3rd base paths only. Outfield as normal.
- Dugouts: first come first serve.

4. Game:

- Coin flip at home plate in pool play games. Furthest team travel calls. Elimination games highest seed has choice.
- Mercy Rule 8 after 5 innings, 10 after 4 innings for ALL games.
- A pitcher will receive 5 warm ups the first inning, 3 every inning thereafter. A new pitcher will receive 5 warm ups.
- Infield/Outfield warm ups are not permitted after 1st inning.
- Courtesy runner for catchers and pitchers are allowed per ASA rules.
- Forfeits scored 7-0.
- No new inning will start after 1 hour 20 minutes from official start time for pool play, finish the inning.
- Elimination games - no new inning after 1 hour 20 minutes from official start time, finish the inning up to semi-final and championship games.
- The official start time will be at which the umpires complete explaining the rules to the coaches and the captains
- Semi-finals and championship games will be 7 inning games unless mercy rule invoked.
- There are no protests. The umpires on the field will make the final decision based on the ASA rules.

5. International Tie Breaker (ITB)

- In pool play games, one inning of ITB will be played to break ties, if the time limit has not expired.
- Ties will be recorded as such in pool play.
- In elimination games, ITB will begin after 80 minutes has elapsed, game is tied, and inning is complete or at 7 innings (whichever comes first). We will play until a winner has been declared. The last batter due up on the offensive team will be placed on 2nd base to start each inning in ITB.

6. Reporting scores

- Each head coach is responsible for informing the tournament director of the score of their game. Scores can be texted to 585-727-8973 or reported to the registration tent located next to the concession stand. Scores at FLCC can be given to designated representative.

7. Seeding for elimination games will be determined by:

1. Points per game (Win=2 points, Tie=1point, Loss=0 points, Forfeit=(-1) point.
2. Head to Head
3. Fewest runs allowed
4. Run differential
5. Coin flip
